

2017 NAFME Northwest Division Conference FAQs

Where is the Conference being held?

The 2017 NAFME Northwest Division Conference will be held at the Bellevue Hyatt Regency Hotel, 900 Bellevue Way NE, Bellevue WA 98004 and the Westin Hotel, 600 Bellevue Way NE, Bellevue 98004.

How do I get to the Hyatt Regency Hotel?

Directions from Sea-Tac Airport: Follow signs to "All Freeways." Take Hwy 518 to 405 northbound to Bellevue (14 miles). Exit onto NE 8th St, West (exit 13B). Follow NE 8th West for 6.5 blocks. The hotel and paid parking are on the right after crossing 106th Ave, at the corner of NE 8th and Bellevue Way.

Directions from I-90 east or westbound: Take 405 north to Bellevue. Exit onto NE 8th St., West (exit 13B). Follow NE 8th West for 6.5 blocks. The hotel and paid parking are on the right after crossing 106th Ave, at the corner of NE 8th and Bellevue Way.

Where is Conference Registration?

Registration will be set up on the lobby level of the Hyatt Regency Hotel, on the east side of the Hyatt Evergreen Ballroom, just past the Grand Staircase (photo on the Hyatt Regency Hotel link)

What methods of payment are accepted at Registration?

Purchase orders: Please take a hard copy of the purchase order with you to Registration.

Checks: Please make checks payable to Washington Music Educators Association.

Cash: US currency only

If I pre-registered, when and where may I pick up my packet?

Will concert tickets be available at Registration?
