Frequently Asked Questions

How do I purchase my very own Music Matters license plate?

Who can purchase a plate?

- Any Washington state vehicle owner.
- The plates may be transferred from vehicle to vehicle as long as the registered owner remains the same.
- Personalized plates are available (normal fees apply—current personalized plates can be transferred to *Music Matters* plates).
- Plates may also be purchased for trucks or motorcycles.

Where do the proceeds from the plates go?

- Funds are earmarked for assisting music departments and students in K-12 public schools.
- The majority of money is distributed via grants to schools where the music programs are in dire need of additional funding.

Can I designate a school to receive funds from my plate?

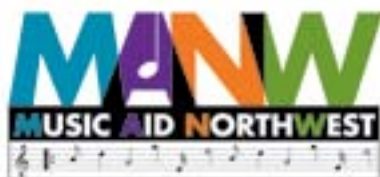
- Yes. Simply follow the instructions below and 60% of the purchase price (after DOL charges) will be sent to the school of your choice. If the school has not registered to receive funds, they will be contacted and invited to join the process.
- Funds designated to schools not registering will be assigned to the “pool” funds that will be set aside for use to assist schools with extreme difficulties supporting music programs.
- Pool funds will be distributed annually to schools whose music departments are struggling to improve. Schools will be selected by a select committee appointed by Music Aid Northwest and WMEA.

How do purchasers communicate their school of choice to receive the funds?

- Once they have the vehicle registration showing their name, address and plate number, they should make a copy, and on that copy do the following:
 1. **Write the school of choice and its city on the registration copy.**
 2. **Write the purchaser's e-mail address on the registration copy.** (For internal use only—will not be shared).
 3. **Send the registration to WMEA by mail or fax as shown below in the right-hand box.**
- A reminder will be sent annually one month before the license renewal is due; once renewed, the purchaser simply sends the new registration copy confirming or changing the school, and that school will receive the funds.
